## General Membership

- Complete Fire Corps training academy
- Participate in three drills per quarter
- Participate in two Fire Corps meetings per quarter
- Participate in 25% of Fire Corps activations

### Food Preparation

- Maintain a food handlers permit
- Be familiar with incidents of activation
  - Fires
  - Long incidents
  - Meal time incidents

### Public Information

- Have PIO training
- Ability to communicate clearly (both written & oral)

### Rehab

- Have Rehab training
- Know the rehab policy
- Ability to set up the rehab equipment
- Ability to drive the rehab unit

### Chaplains

- Complete chaplaincy training
- Be familiar activation process
- Be aware of any situation before entering
- Be familiar with radio protocol
- Participate in annual Blood borne Pathogens training

### Photography

- Have photography experience or training
- Be aware of any situation before entering
- Be familiar with common incident hazards
- Be Safe

### Fire Investigation / Inspection / YFP&IS

- Complete Fire Investigation training;
- Work within CFIT procedures; or
- Youth Fire Prevention and Intervention Services; or
- Complete Fire Inspection training; and
- Be aware of any situation before entering
- Work within policies
- Be safe

### EMS

- EMS response is out of Fire Corps and is an Operational issue
- All other EMS training is for Rehab
